

The project

“Qualifizierung und Beschäftigung von jungen Frauen“ (Course of Qualification for young Women)

is taking place since the year 2000 in the “**Technikzentrum des Internationalen Bunds**” (technical centre of *Internationaler Bund*) in Frankfurt am Main.

Since April 2016 we are able to offer that course to **three additional women/refugees** who arrived lately in Germany.

According to the motto “**Arriving & Working – Active Integration**” we can offer following support to girls and women aged up to 27 years, that live in the state of Hessen and that do not obtain SGB II:

- ✓ **Arrive and orientate in Germany/ Frankfurt and surrounding**
- ✓ Get to know the educational system and occupational ways in Germany
- ✓ How can the certificates from my home country be acknowledged in Germany?
- ✓ **Screening tests and survey of skills**
- ✓ **German lesson and additional training dependent on requirements**
- ✓ Visiting companies and **find a place for practical work experience**
- ✓ **Get to know different occupational areas**
- ✓ **Creative and skilled manual work**
- ✓ Round table for women related topics
- ✓ Sponsorship by young women from Frankfurt

Individual support of the women, made possible by the **small group size** (15 participants, 3 pedagogues), is very important for us. A **gender homogenous group and support only by female pedagogues** provides a safe space for the refugees to stabilize, to orientate and to develop (new) perspectives.

An entry is possible at any time.
